### Membership database

#### summary

The chamber will not provide a copy of the membership database, either electronic or hard copy, in part or full to any organisation other than Gold and Platinum support partners who have signed the relevant partnership agreement and the Chambers' subcontractors with regard sanctioned mail outs.

#### 18 September 2008

The above policy was amended from 'sponsors' to 'support partners'; removed who have paid in full' to reflect current terminology and support partner eligibility criteria.

#### 29 May 2005

It was proposed that the following policy for the membership database be accepted. The chamber will not provide a data file either electronic or hard copy to any organisation other than Gold and Platinum Sponsors who have paid in full or who have signed the relevant partnership agreement and the Chambers' subcontractors with regard sanctioned mail outs. However, there is an exception – the Chamber is to honour a verbal agreement with The Taggart Group to have access, once sponsorship is paid in full. This policy will only be executed once 1) all members have been contacted and permission (or refusal) for business details to be included in the database, under the requirements of the privacy act and 2) All future partnership agreements clearly define the use of the membership database.

#### 27 September 2004

It was proposed that the database would be made available to members in a single electronic file for a fee. This would require further investigation and a great deal of work setting protocols and buy in from members. At present the membership data base is available to any interested party through the internet. The chamber does not provide a data file either electronic or hard copy to any organisation other than the relevant subcontractors with regard sanctioned mail outs.
